'EGGSTRA' SPECIAL EASTER EGG RECYCLING CHALLENGE - 2025

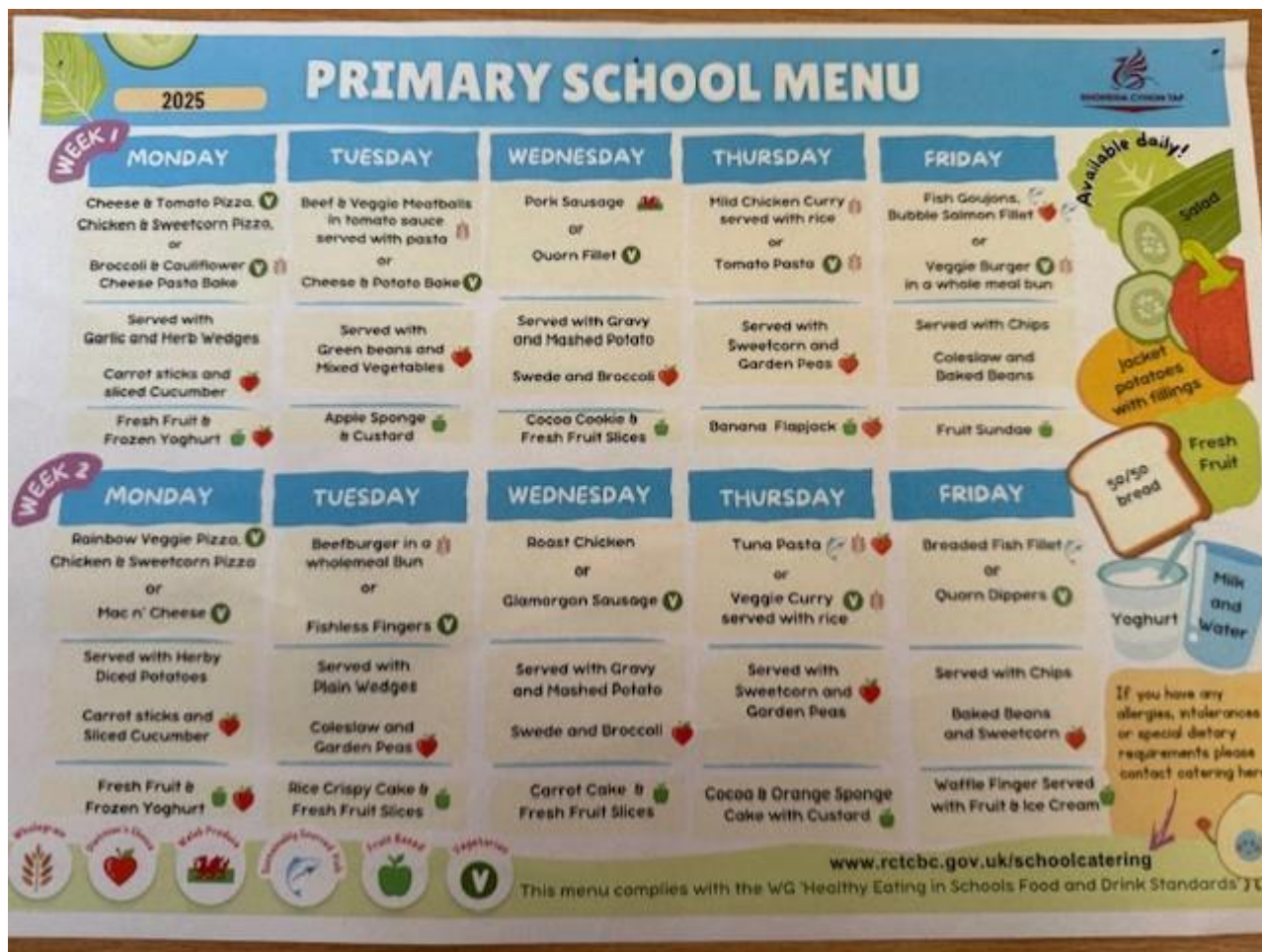
