Cardiff City Football Training for Year 6

This term we have organised for the Cardiff City Foundation to work with the children at our after school football club. The coaching staff at the Cardiff City Foundation are able to offer professional and fun coaching sessions to help children gain confidence through sport and develop their skill in football, regardless of prior experience or ability.

The **sessions will last for 6 weeks, the total cost of the sessions is £10 per child.** This permission slip along with £10 will need to be paid to Main Reception before Session 1 in order to secure a place. The remainder of the cost of the sessions will be subsidized by the school.

The first session will **begin on Tuesday 8th April and will run every Tuesday for 6 weeks, the last session will be on Tuesday 3rd June. All sessions will end at 4:30pm.** The after school club is **limited to 16 places** and will operate on a 'first come, first served' basis. On the days your child has after school football club, can you please send them to school in suitable footwear and bottoms, with their school polo shirt and jumper. Your child does not need to bring clothes to change into as this will affect session timings.

Please return the form to Main Reception as soon as possible. We anticipate that the club will be very popular.

Please could you also specify if your child is walking home or is being picked up by an adult.

Please note: if your child is being picked up by an adult, adults will need to walk down to the office at the Main Reception. All children will need to be picked up from there.
