## Collaboration

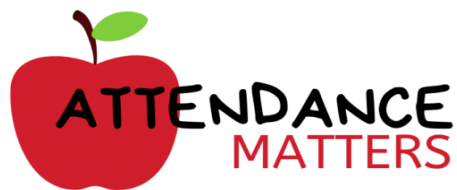
