### FOL 5p Challenge



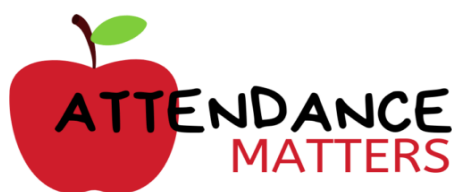
Each class has been excited to start the **5p Challenge**.
