**Have you claimed all the support you can get with school costs?**

The Welsh Government offers support with Free School Meals and School Essentials such as uniform, kit and stationery.

**Make sure you've checked your child's eligibility** for Free School Meals. Even if they receive Universal Primary Free Schools Meals, **more help** could be available!

**If eligible:**

- you can get up to **£200 per child** for School Essentials
- your school will get at least **£1,150** of **extra funding**

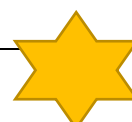
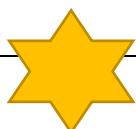


Attendance for this week is 91.86%
