Congratulations to both boys. It was a superb event, with very special memories made.



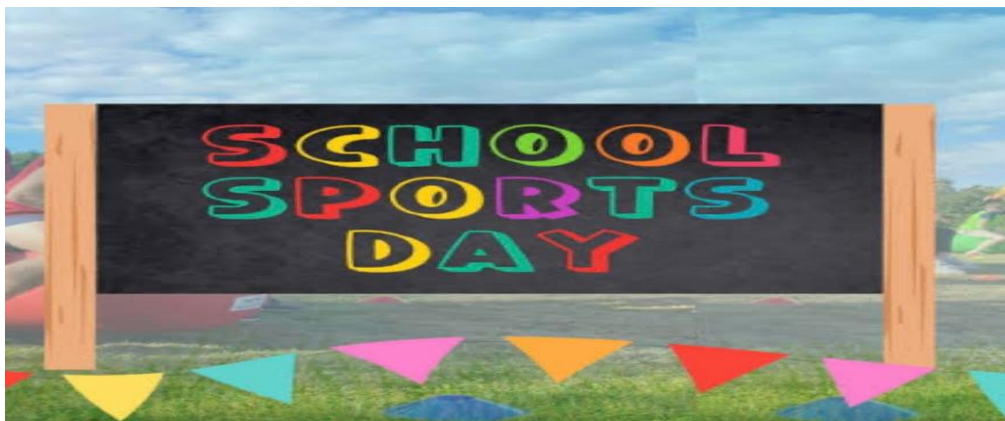


Huge Congratulations to Mrs Arnold, Mrs Heaven and Mrs Swain's Classes who have collectively won the 5p Challenge.

Reserve Sports Day is **Thursday June 18th**. We are hoping that the weather remains dry so that it can go ahead.

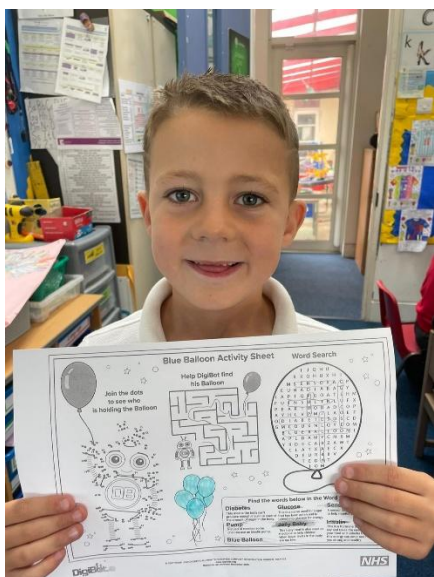
Diabetes Week
