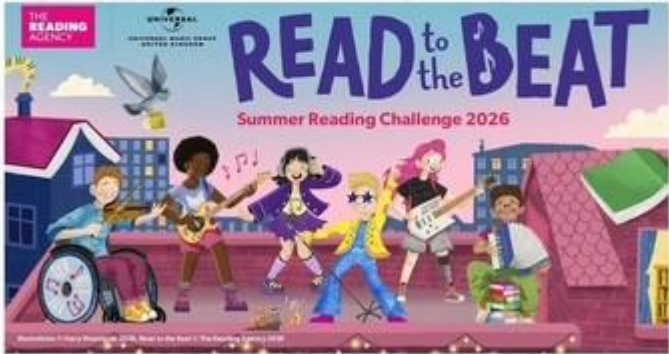


African Drumming
