It was great end of Spring Term. The pupils came dressed in their own clothes.

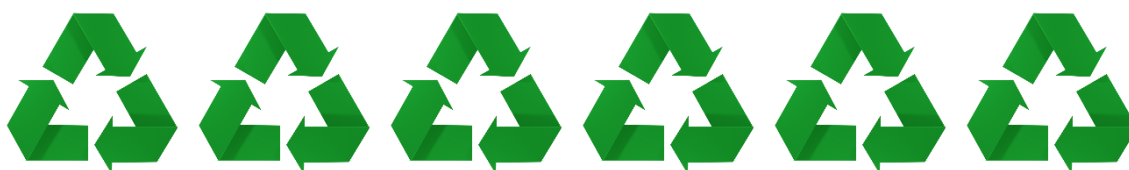
Our younger pupils had Easter Bonnet parades and our older pupils decorated a hard-boiled egg.
