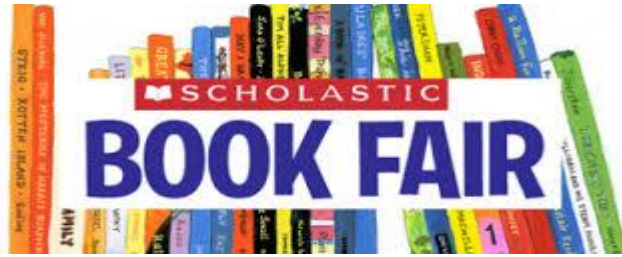
It was a superb evening, made very special for everyone, and was also very emotional.

We are pleased to announce that we sold **£360** worth of books.



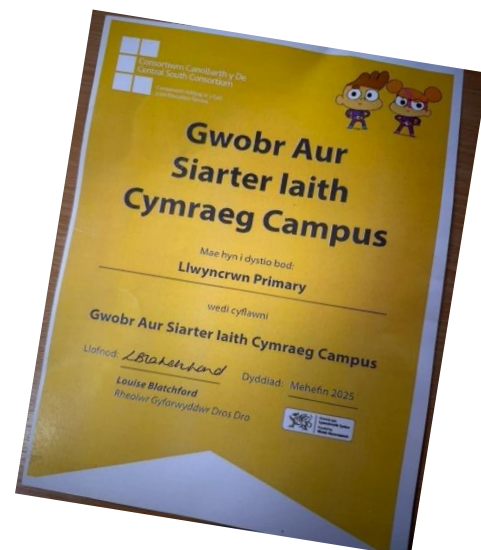
## 5p Challenge

- Everything was amazing! The assembly was the highlight but it was fab to see the evidence submitted and to have a walk around the school.

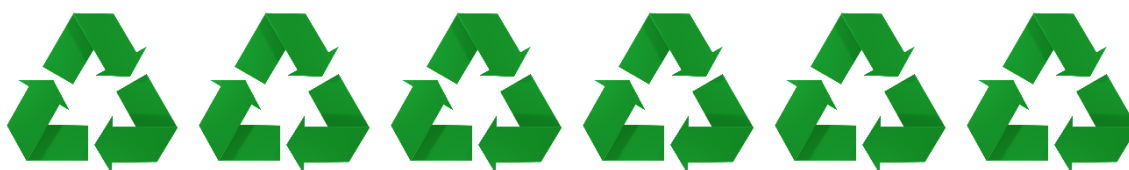
#### Fire Service visit
