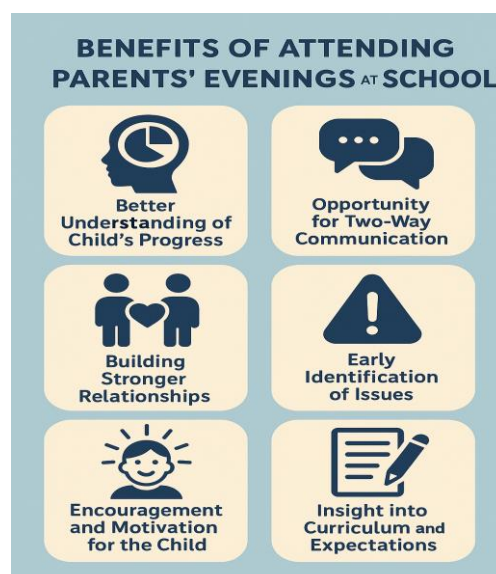
We have had quite changeable weather this week. "Even when skies are grey, the promise of colour is just beyond the clouds."
