In the Spring Term, the other KS2 classes will have swimming sessions.

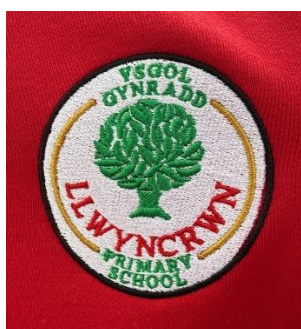
School Uniform

Safeguarding

With more and more reported incidents reported in schools on the news and social media, it is not surprising that parents/carers may be concerned or worried about the safety of their children whilst at school.

Please be assured that the safety of all our pupils, and all staff, is our number one priority. We are regularly inspected for Health and Safety and also Safeguarding matters, as we were in March 2025.

The procedures we have in place at Llwynocrwn include:

We have locked gates, with limited access through the day and a barrier in place to prevent unwanted vehicular movement.

All Reception doors are fobbed, and we have cameras positioned in various trigger points throughout the school.

When pupils are outside on breaks, they are always observed and managed by staff.

All staff and visitors must sign in and out on our Halo Communication Sign up tablet.

We have regular Fire and Lockdown Drills.

If you are concerned about any safety aspects at Llwynocrwn, please do not hesitate to come into school to discuss the matter with us.
