Thank you to the staff who planned this event, and those who took part.

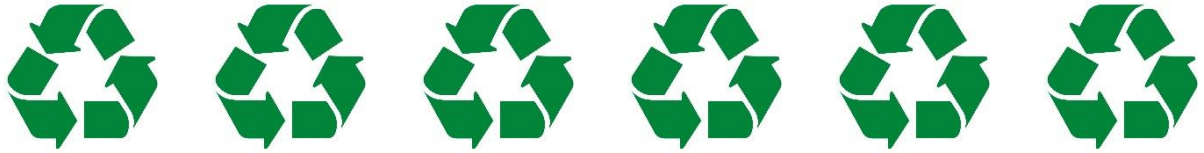
## Year 6
